Misc. Notes: Drove NE from Hayuliang to Goliang. Trekked NE from Goliang to Mishmi village of Braigong. Braigong is approx. 12 mi. NE of Hayuliang. Hired local hunter, Malingsa Towsit, in Braigong village. Crash site is on ancestral hunting grounds of Towsit family. Malingsa's father, Rumlamso Towsit, found crash site in 1962 while hunting on W flank of Walong Mtn. Crash site is 5-day trek NE of Braigong, at end of valley on W flank of Walong Mtn. and at headwaters of Halai River.
